BE CONSIDERATE

Generator Usage

- >Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 3:30am. No operation of generators during this time.
- >External generators must be at least 2 feet off the ground. Position generator exhaust away from neighboring guests.
- >Loud construction type generators are **NOT** allowed.

Pets

- >All pets must be on a leash when outside of the RV.
- >Pet owners must be considerate and clean up after your pet.
- >Pets are not allowed inside Balloon Fiesta Park unless they are a service animal with the proper designations.
- >Please be aware that some pets can become frightened at loud noises, such as hot air balloon burners and fireworks.

Smoking

>**No** smoking is allowed in any of the RV lots per the City of Albuquerque and the Fire Marshall's Office.

BBQ Grills

- >PROPANE OR PELLET BBQ grills are allowed in the RV lots but charcoal grills are not allowed. Open flames, such as wood burner fire pits are not allowed in any RV lots.
- >Grills must be 2 feet off the ground.
- >If it has been discovered that you are using the grill for purposes other than cooking food, you may be asked to leave as a violation of the BBQ grill rule.

Trash

Please keep your RV site clean. Place trash in the provided receptacles.

Potable Water/ Pumping Service

Potable water fills and pumping service is conducted by AAA Pumping Service. Passes can be purchased at the check-in tent in each lot. AAA will be servicing each lot daily; times will vary based on need.

Water fills: \$30.00 each time Waste pumping: \$30.00 each time

ABSOLUTELY NO dumping of gray or black water on the ground.

Portable Toilets/ Restrooms

Portable toilets/restrooms are available at various locations in each RV lot. Please leave all supplies for other guests to enjoy.

Event/Session Cancellation

AIBF assumes no responsibility for cancellation of Balloon Fiesta Park activities due to weather or safety considerations. The event is weather dependent.

Electric Water Heater Usage

- >Allowed only in President's Compound and Premium.
- >Use propane water heater in all other RV lots.

Transportation Service

Transportation service is **FREE** for RV guests in our South RV lot. Look for the **"Shuttle Stop"** signs or flags. Handicap accommodations for transportation to the launch field is available.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Motorized Alternative Transportation

- >Loud motorized transportation vehicles will NOT be allowed.
- >Golf carts or ATVs will NOT be allowed for personal use in the RV lots unless prior approval by AIBF.
- >Speed Limit is 5mph in all RV lots.
- >Scooters are available for rent at the north and south guest gates.

Campfires

><u>NO</u> campfires or propane fire pits are allowed per the Albuquerque Fire Department. Anyone caught burning a campfire of any sort will result in removal from the RV lot.

Fire Lanes

>Fire lanes are marked between rows and must be respected at all times. **DO NOT** block fire lanes. Any vehicle blocking a fire lane will be towed.

Drones

>NO drones or any other unauthorized flying aircraft are allowed in any of the RV lots. A temporary flight restriction (TFR) is established within a 4 nautical mile radius of Balloon Fiesta Park. Any drone flight activity within the TFR will be subject to civil penalties and fines.

>Balloon Fiesta is a **NO DRONE ZONE.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

RV Parking Hours

September 30th through October 4th 8:00am -6:45pm*

October 5th through October 10th 12:00pm – 6:45pm*

It is strongly suggested that you arrive before 3:00pm on days that have two sessions (Saturday-Sunday & Thursday-Saturday) to avoid heavy traffic congestion which could delay your check-in process.

*allows time for those in line at 6:45pm to check-in until 7:00pm

There will be no parking after 7:00pm.

Vehicles arriving after 7:00pm will be staged overnight for next day parking.

Morning Check Out:

10:00am to 11:30am

Parking

An AIBF RV Volunteer will guide you to your parking space and will assist with parking. *All parking is Rally-Style or first come first serve*. Parking after Balloon Fiesta starts will be directed by the RV Volunteers to the next available space.

- >Once that you have been parked by the RV volunteer, you are not allowed to move your RV until check-out.
- >Parking within all RV lots is at the discretion of AIBF and the RV volunteers.
- >Spaces cannot be held for guests. If you want to park beside another guest, you will need to arrive together.
- >The RV parking placard must be placed so it is visible to RV volunteers as they drive by.
- >Each RV space will receive one Tow/Toad parking placard.

Additional Tow placards can be purchased at the check-in booth for **\$30.00** each up to 2 additional passes.

>AIBF reserves the right to ask you to move your RV/Tow at any time.

-No tent camping is allowed in any RV lots, except for the designated tent camping area in the VIP West lot.

Balloon Fiesta General Admission

An admission ticket is required for entry into Balloon Fiesta Park for each session. Tickets can be purchased (www.balloonfiesta.com), at the Balloon Fiesta Gift Shop located at 4401 Alameda Blvd (the corner of Alameda & Balloon Museum Dr.) or at the guest gate entrances.

- >Adults & children 13 years and older: \$15.00
- >Children under 13 years old: Free
- >**President's Compound** will receive 4 general admission tickets per session per day.
- >VIP East & VIP West will receive 2 general admission tickets per session per day.
- >Premium, Box View & Standard do not come with general admission tickets.
